This is ______ : CQ – Good evening and welcome to the Highland Lakes Amateur Radio Emergency Services Net.

If there are stations with EMERGENCY or PRIORITY traffic for the net please identify with your call sign and when requested, pass your traffic. Please Call NOW.

[If any, check them in and pass traffic immediately]

If you have emergency traffic at any time during the net please announce with BREAK BREAK. You will be immediately recognized by the net control to pass your traffic.

This is a directed net, sponsored by the American Radio Relay League and the Highland Lakes Amateur Radio Club. It is held weekly on Sunday Night at 2030 hours local time on a frequency of 147.020 MHz (tone 88.5 Hertz) courtesy of the repeater trustee, **KC0TA**. Our Back Up Repeater is 145.390 MHz (tone 103.5 Hertz) courtesy of the repeater trustee **N5KUQ**. This net is a local net of the National Traffic System (NTS).

Our practice is not to unkey the microphone PTT and not to leave a space when identifying your station.

When checking in, please use standard ITU phonetics.

[During an extended NET, Net Control should ask about every three – five minutes for additional check-ins and emergency/priority traffic.]

We will hold any Training after all check-ins to the net. Members are asked to remain on frequency until the training session is completed. After any training session(s) we will open the net for your comments on any topic.

At this time HL-ARES and HLARC members and visitors are welcome to check into the net. Please use standard ITU phonetics and be recognized individually. Call now.

[Call back stations with training or any other remaining business items. If none proceed to the informal net.]

This completes formal ARES Net Business. The NET is now declared INFORMAL and is open for comments by all club members and guests.

Comments are invited from all check-ins. [This allows radio checks for all. Recognize each check in individually.]

[After comments are completed ask again for additional traffic and for additional checkins]

Any stations with Emergency or Priority traffic please check in now.

Are there any additional check-ins for the net this evening?

[Recognize additional check ins individually and ask for comments.

[Confirm check-ins and any other items for the required documentation with the net backup]
